

Lighthouse Rules and Regulations

The Preservation Association would like to welcome you to the historic Ponce de Leon Inlet Lighthouse. We hope you enjoy the upcoming Light Station tour and your climb to the top of Florida's tallest lighthouse. Because the Light Station is a historic monument and museum we ask that you follow these simple rules during your visit:

- **Stay with your group at all times during the tour.**
- **Use active listening skills and raise your hand when answering or asking questions during the tour.**
- **Food, drinks, and backpacks are prohibited within the historic Light Station grounds.**
- **Students must be accompanied by a chaperon at all times.**
- **All climbers must be able to climb up and down the tower without assistance.**
- **Running, jumping, and stomping on the Lighthouse stairs and landings is forbidden.**
- **Do not pass other climbers except on the landings.**
- **Climbers may not wear flip flops or high heeled shoes.**
- **Please use the hand railings at all times while climbing the tower.**
- **The throwing of any objects from the top of the lighthouse or down its interior weight well is strictly forbidden.**
